



Prof. Budi Wiweko, MD, PhD, OG-REI- MPH, FRANZCOG (Hons), FICRM

Prof. Dr. Budi Wiweko is an esteemed expert in Obstetrics and Gynecology, recognized for his significant contributions to the field. He completed his undergraduate medical education and specialized in Obstetrics and Gynecology at the Faculty of Medicine, Universitas Indonesia, obtaining his specialist degree in 2005. He later enhanced his expertise in Assisted Reproductive Technology in Japan and became a Reproductive Endocrinology and Infertility Consultant in 2009.

Dr. Wiweko earned a PhD from Universitas Indonesia in 2014 and a Master of Public Health from Gadjah Mada University in 2017. His academic prowess led to his promotion as a professor in the Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology at Universitas Indonesia in 2018. Notably, he has been recognized as an International Affiliate of the Royal Australian and New Zealand College of Obstetricians and Gynaecologists (RANZCOG) and is set to receive further honors fellowship from the college in 2024.

Currently, Dr. Wiweko serves as the Chairman of the Academic Senate at Universitas Indonesia, as well as holding pivotal roles in numerous professional organizations, including as the President Elect of the Indonesian Society of Obstetrician and Gynecologist. His past leadership positions include the presidency of ASPIRE, a regional initiative on reproduction.

Dr. Wiweko is also active in various committees such as the chairman of The Reproductive Endocrinology and Infertility Committee of AOFOG, and he is dedicated to advancing the field through research and education, holding significant roles as a Vice Director at the Indonesian Medical Education and Research Institute (IMERI).

Dr. Wiweko has published 160 papers indexed in Scopus and 77 papers indexed in PubMed, with a h-index of 16, demonstrating his significant impact in the field of obstetrics and gynecology. His commitment to medical science and education, combined with his extensive qualifications and

leadership roles, establishes Prof. Dr. Budi Wiweko as a prominent figure in obstetrics and gynecology, both nationally and internationally.
